In the past I used a hacksaw to cut PVC pipes but no more. Only 5-6 rotations of this tool and you'll get a perfectly square cut.

It'll make bathroom plumbing so much easier, trust me on this one.

Cost: \$29 to \$35



Magnetic Screwdriving Bit Drive Guide

Do you ever need an extra hand while DIYing?

Yet it's no where to be found!!

Well my friend you need a magnetic bit guide to help you out.

I couldn't imagine hanging drywall or drilling anything into a wall without one of these.
